



Dear tenant, take part!

Separate your garbage to conserve environment as well as your purse. You may decrease your ancillary rental expenses. See how it works.

- Buy unpacked goods – whenever it is possible, e.g. unpacked instead of packed vegetable. Use refill systems. Returnable bottles.
- Use different garbage containers of your housing department – because the more valuable substances you dispose separately the less residual waste with costs is left.

WASTE SEPARATION – IT'S SO EASY:

CARDBOARD/PAPER



Paper and cardboard go into the public paper collecting containers close by, e.g.

- Cardboard boxes
- Newspapers, magazines
- Catalogues
- Cardboard packaging with the “Grüner Punkt”

GLASS



Bottles and glasses with the “Grüner Punkt”

go into the public glass collecting containers close by sorted by colours. Blue glass goes to green glass.

Window glass and mirrors go into the grey residual waste container of the AWG.

PACKAGING



Packaging with the “Grüner Punkt” go into the yellow refuse bin.

- **Plastic packaging**, e.g. plastic bottles, yoghurt cups, foils, tubes of toothpaste, styrofoam plates
- **Metal packaging**, e.g. beverage cans and tins, tin foil
- **Composite packaging**, e.g. juice, sauce and milk cartons

Cardboard packaging like e.g. for frozen goods go into waste paper.

RESIDUAL WASTE



Any other packaging not made of cardboard/paper, glass or metal, without “Grüner Punkt” and not containing any pollutants go into the residual waste container, e.g.

- Diapers, paper tissues
- Porcelain
- Toys
- Plants (if no bio-waste container is available)
- Flowerpots
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Contents of any type

BULKY REFUSE POLLUTANTS

Everything else not going into the refuse bin because of size or type, e.g. chairs, mattresses, racks, carpets, bicycles, electrical devices, is considered as bulky refuse.

Dates for bulky refuse for your street are listed in the waste calendar of the AWG. In the event of real urgent cases there is the

that requires a charge or the disposal of bulky refuse at the recycling centres of the AWG that requires a charge as well.

Pollutants like e.g. paint, varnish, household chemicals, and batteries do not go into the refuse bins!

You may leave pollutants at the “Schadstoffmobil” of the AWG without costs. Dates and locations are listed in the waste calendar.
